From our Rabbi

Dreamers have always been ridiculed throughout history. Yet without there would be no historical movements, scientific breakthroughs or societal upheavals. The status quo would have been universally accepted and never challenged.

The former Chief Rabbi of the British Empire Lord Jonathan Sacks, tells a wonderful story that was told to him by the Nobel Prize winning author and Holocaust survivor, Eli Wiesel. Dr. Sigmund Freud, the famous psychoanalyst and Theodor Herzl, the father of modern political Zionism, once lived in the same district of Vienna.

"Fortunately," Wiesel said, "they never met." Can you imagine what would have happened had they met? Herzl would have said, "I have a dream of a Jewish state." Freud would have responded, "Tell me Herr Herzl, how long have you been having this dream? Lie down on my couch and I will psychoanalyze you." Herzl would have been cured of his dream and there would be NO JEWISH STATE."

The same can be said about other dreamers throughout history. Abraham, fearing the rejection of his family and friends, might have continued worshipping the idols of his father, Terah. Joseph would have accepted his fate as Pharaoh's prisoner. Had he done so, and not aspired to his position of leadership in Egypt, millions might have died of starvation. Judah Maccabeus might have never led a successful campaign for religious freedom against the tyrant Antiochus. Esther, in fear of her own survival, might have remained silent about Haman's plan to exterminate Persian Jews. The United States, England, France, and the Allied Powers might have accepted the "reality" of a Central Europe dominated by Adolph Hitler and the death of many more than SIX MILLION JEWS and TWENTY ONE MILLION EUROPEANS. The Berlin Wall might never have come down. Dr. Martin Luther King might never have dreamed his "dream".

Congregation Beth Israel Sinai has been a source of Jewish culture, education, prayer, and "simchas" in Southeastern Wisconsin and Northern Illinois for over 150 years. Our "dream" is to continue to serve as a traditional, egalitarian Jewish house of worship into the 21st century and beyond. As Dr. Herzl said: "If you have the will, it is no dream."
